Classwork:

This is the last week of work distribution. All paper schoolwork must be turned in by 5/27 and online work by midnight on 5/29. This enables teachers to get work graded and final grades input during that last week.

School Materials and Books:

All ipads and schoolbooks are due on or before June 3rd. The office is open 11-1 Mon-Wed to the public. You may drop off items anytime the office is open.

Food Distribution:

If you are on our meal distribution list, our last distribution date for this schoolyear is Wednesday, June 3rd.

Yearbooks:

Yearbooks will be available for distribution in the office on June 1, 2, or 3 from 11-1. The total cost is \$35. If you put down the \$10 deposit you will owe \$25 upon pick up, if not it will be \$35. Cash or check only.

Sports and Scholarship Night:

In lieu of an in person event, we will stream a scholarship and sports awards recognition on Monday, June 1, at 6:00 p.m. At that time scholarship and sports awards recipients will be announced. More info on where to tune in to follow.

Next Year's Return Plan:

The superintendents across the county will continue to follow and abide by the Public Health Officer's guidelines in regards to school opening and events. Currently they have agreed to either open campuses fully or start the year with Distance Learning until we are allowed to do so.
