TK AND KINDERGARTEN REGISTRATION

TK/Kindergarten registration will be on April 11, 2025 from 8:30am to 12:00pm at Tenaya Elementary School. You must have an appointment. Please contact Saira at 209-962-7846 to secure a spot. Children eligible for TK must turn 5 between September 2, 2025 and June 2, 2026. Children eligible for Kindergarten must be 5 years old by September 1, 2025. You will need to bring the following:

- Birth Certificate or Proof of Age
- Immunization Records and Well Health Care Exam
- Proof of Residency (Utility Bill, Lease, etc.)
- Parent/Guardian ID and Registration Packet
